- **Steven M. Sutton Small Business of the Year** - Recognition of established business of 2-50 employees
- **Rookie Business of the Year** - Recognition of business in existence for 3 years or less and shows great promise for continued success. 2-50 employees
- **Independent Business of the Year** - Recognition of individually owned and operated business with no employees who is not supported or backed by a corporation or franchise
